A Visiting Faculty appointment is open at Antioch University Seattle in the area of environmental studies in the B.A. in Liberal Studies Program, beginning October 4, 2010. Antioch University Seattle faculty engage in teaching, research, and service; the successful applicant will teach undergraduate courses, assist in designing curricula, advise students, and serve on special committees. This position is three-quarter time (75% FTE), with a 9-month service period.

Applicants must have a Master's degree, in a relevant area. Must be highly qualified for undergraduate teaching and independent research, with prior teaching experience at the university level, preferably with an adult student population. This position includes teaching undergraduate environmental studies courses as well as participating in regularly scheduled program meetings. This position would also involve participation in special committees and University task forces for the B.A. in Liberal Studies Program as well as serving as a Teaching Liaison. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply.
