A visiting faculty appointment with administrative duties is open at Antioch University Seattle in the Doctoral Psychology Program in the School of Applied Psychology, Counseling, and Family Therapy beginning July 1, 2010. Antioch University Seattle faculty engage in teaching, research and service; the successful applicant will teach graduate courses, participate in the administration of clinical training programs and supervise student clinical work and/or research. This position is full-time (100% FTE), with a 12-month service period.

Applicants must have a Psy.D., Ph.D. or equivalent doctoral degree in a related field from an accredited university, be licensed or licensable in Washington State as a clinical psychologist with a minimum of two years post-licensure experience. Preference will be given to candidates who have experience teaching at the graduate university level as well as experience in administration of clinical training programs. We desire a proven history of active participation in teaching, clinical practice, supervision, research, clinical administration work and experience with multicultural competency. The successful applicant must be highly qualified to supervise students, participate in the practica and internship placement process, teach at the graduate level, engage in active research programs, work with innovative clinical interventions and engage with public policy. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply. The ideal candidate will complement and build on existing strengths within the school, and will be eager to interact with students and faculty from the broader community at Antioch University Seattle.
