Courses with research components allow you to explore various themes and ideas in preparation for your leadership project. You must complete 48 credits to earn the degree and usually do so within six quarters, attending full time.

During the final quarter of the program, you complete a inquiry project, integrating your academic and professional interests in Native culture and education.
